I had the pleasure of attending the Babel Med conference in Marseilles, France twice in the last 5 years. I highly recommend this conference for world music presenters who are seeking high quality acts and gaining knowledge of some of the best world artists based in France/Europe. The conference is well attended by a vibrant mix of music programmers, festival directors, agents and managers from all over Europe and beyond, although mostly European focused with the emphasis on France. The venue is one of the best at the Docks des Suds. All the showcases are under one roof with high production values and easy manoeuvrability to get to all the shows. Also the showcases are attended by the public as a festival so the delegates get a real sense of a public concert from the showcasing artists. There is a VIP area set up in the venue specifically for delegates so networking in this area is very good as it's the most focused area for meeting other delegates. I made lots of great artist discoveries as well as good contacts.
